

350 plus students benefit from IIM-T placements

Trichy: Indian Institute of Management Tiruchirappalli (IIM-T) completed its summer and final placements process 2024, in which more than 350 students benefited.

An array of 140 companies extended 326 positions to students of postgraduate program in management (PGPM) students and 37 students of PGPM human resource.

The placement process witnessed 158% surge in engagement from FMCG companies. The stipends reached ₹3.5 lakh for PGPM and ₹3 lakh for PGPM HR students.
