IIM Trichy Celebrates its Seventh Foundation Day

IIM Tiruchirappalli (IIMT) celebrated its 7th Foundation Day on the 4th of January, 2018 with a grand function. The Foundation Day marks the **inception of IIM Trichy** as the 11th Indian Institute of Management.

The event was inaugurated with the lighting of the lamp by the Chief Guest, Mr. Ganesh Ramamoorthy, Managing Vice President of Gartner (India), Guest of Honour, Mr. Venkat Viswanathan, Founder and Chairman, LatentView Analytics, Mr. Jalaj Dani, Chairman, Board of Governors, IIM Trichy, Dr. Bhimaraya Metri, Director, IIM Trichy, and Prof. V. He urged the students to keep the **human factor** in mind as they go through the curriculum.

One of the teams, comprising of final year students Bala Koteshwar Kolluri, Reshma Rayadurgam, Cherishma Duggina, Harish M S, Rohit Sribhashyam, Deekshitha Reddy Gagireddy was awarded a certificate of appreciation for their project titled "*Self-Empowerment to Rural Women via Food Product Business*". The student team wanted to make a difference to the rural women who had very little chances of employment. The students met the rural women and hand held them through the labelling, pricing and packing of the product. The Chief Guest honoured the students with **certificates of appreciation**.

The vote of thanks was proposed by Prof. V. Gopal. The program ended with the National Anthem.
