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Notice Inviting Tender

Over View

1. Indian Institute of Management Tiruchirappalli (IIM Tiruchirappalli), an Institute of National Importance, established by the Ministry of Education (Shiksha Mantralaya), Govt. of India, is the eleventh IIM and was instituted on 4th January 2011. More details about IIM Tiruchirappalli are available on our website www.iimtrichy.ac.in.
2. IIM Tiruchirappalli invites Tender for “*Providing Catering Services along with Infrastructure arrangements for the Eleventh Annual Convocation at IIM Tiruchirappalli*” (Scheduled on 05th April 2023).

Scope of works

1. Arrangement of the following:

- a. Refreshment on 04th April 2023 for the Rehearsal at 9.30 a.m. for **700** members as per the Menu provided in [Annexure III-A](#).
- b. Convocation-eve Dinner on 04th April 2023 from 7:30 pm to 10:30 pm at Lake View Area of the Institute for **1200** members along with Infrastructure. The Menu is provided in [Annexure III-B](#).
- c. Pre-convocation High Tea on 05th April 2023 from 3.30 pm to 5.00 pm – for **1200** members as per the Menu provided in [Annexure III-C](#).
- d. Post-Convocation Tiffin on 05th April 2023 at 7.30 pm for **1500** members as per the Menu provided in [Annexure III-D](#).

Note: Timing may slightly vary as per the requirement of the Institute.

Special conditions relating to the tender:

1. Being a food supply contract, all the edible materials like rice, dal, oil, sugar, jaggery, suji, etc. used by the contractor should be of good quality, free from insects and other adulteration/decay materials. Dalda/Vanaspathi, food colour and Ajinomoto should not be used in the food.
2. No wet utensils should be found in the venue. Sufficient number of wooden spoons to be available near the dessert counter.
3. Fresh fruits and vegetables are to be used. There would be inspection made by the authorities to check the quality of food/ingredient contents.
4. Any shortfall in the quantity of the food items, any lacuna in the service provided, serving food of unacceptable quality or non-compliance with any terms of this tender document will unarguably invite a **penalty of up to 20%** of the value of the contract. The actual extent of the penalty will be decided by IIM Tiruchirappalli.
5. ***Electricity and domestic water (other than cooking purpose) will be provided by the Institute and applicable charges will be levied for the electricity and water.***
6. All utensils, fuel, and any other items required for cooking should be brought by the vendor. IIM Tiruchirappalli will only provide the necessary space for cooking. The shelter with necessary cooking equipment/furniture etc. should be created/arranged by the Vendor under his/her own cost.
7. Only RO water should be used for cooking. Cooking water will not be provided by the Institute.
8. The prices quoted by the bidders will be deemed inclusive of transportation charges and any other charges (including packing, forwarding, freight charges, Transit Insurance and any other charges as applicable).
9. The vessels used for cooking should be well cleaned to prevent any form of fungal development or other food poisoning chances.
10. Cutlery, glasses and plates used for the event should have been cleaned by hot water with proper disinfectant cleaning materials.
11. The people engaged in cooking and serving should be well-groomed, their dresses freshly washed, and their hair properly covered to maintain good hygiene during the event.
12. Separate counter for used plates be made available by the vendor.
13. Leftovers in the plates should be kept away from the serving counters to avoid contamination of the food that is kept ready for serving. The vendor needs to check and clear the leftovers immediately and should not allow the leftovers to accumulate anywhere in the venue.
14. Successful bidders should make adequate arrangements for the disposal of the cooking and serving waste outside the Institute campus in line with the guidelines of local administration.

15. The cooking should be done inside the campus/dinner venue only. Hence, necessary shed has to be created by the vendor and the space for the same will be allotted by the institute.
16. Transportation of all material, vessels, cutlery and other implements, as well as their people, is entirely within the scope of the Bidder.
17. The food preparation should be completed and ready to be served by 7.30 pm on April 04, 2023.
18. Food is to be prepared in sufficient quantity and the food counters are to be prepared in a systematic way to cater for 1200 guests.
19. Necessary approval, if required, will be accorded to permit entry of furniture items, crockery, cutlery, etc. to ensure timely preparation of food and arrangements.
20. Necessary safety precautions are to be ensured to avoid any fire/accident at the venue.
21. Post completion of the event, the area is to be cleaned and cleared on the same day.

Provision of the following items/services:

22. High quality crockery (bone china material), steel cutlery, serving bowls, serving spoons, wooden spoons, cloth napkins, food warmers to be spread on serving counters to cater to all the guests.
23. Serving Counters with table cloth and frills.
24. Sufficient numbers of stewards and qualified cooks (separate chefs for North Indian and South Indian foods) in proper, clean uniform with hand gloves and head caps to enable preparation and serving of food.
25. Four/six-seater round dining tables to cater for 250 number of guests.
26. Fresh, clean, wrinkle-free and neat white cloth cover for dining tables with maroon colour frill around the tables.
27. Plastic Chairs with fresh, clean, wrinkle-free and neat white colour cloth wrapped.

Requirements for Serving Convocation-Eve Dinner

1. The Convocation-eve Dinner will be arranged on 04th April 2023 from 7:30 pm to 10:30 pm at Lake View Area of the Institute.
2. The convocation-eve Dinner should be served for approximately **1200** members.
3. The Menu for Dinner is provided in [Annexure III-B](#). The bidders are required to provide the itemized prices and the total amount for serving the Menu to **1200** members.
4. The bidders should have the capability to prepare all food items in the Venue (IIM Tiruchirappalli) and serve them hot/fresh to the members.

5. Convocation Eve Dinner (Lake View Area at 7.30 pm on 04th April 2023):

- a. In the serving area, the following Counters need to be set up by the vendor:
 - i. At least Three live counters for Chaat items
 - ii. At least Three live counters of Dosa items
 - iii. At least Three live counters of Dessert items
 - iv. At least Four counters for Veg main course
 - v. At least Four counters for Non-Veg main course
- b. Veg. and Non-Veg. Counters are to be set up separately, and all the counters should be adequately staffed.
- c. The food serving stalls have to be arranged by the bidders as per the instructions provided by IIM Tiruchirappalli. The serving stalls should be equipped to serve hot food. The containers used for serving the food items should have the continuous heating facility.
- d. The Cutlery necessary for serving and eating has to be provided by the bidders in sufficient quantities. The Cutlery should be of excellent quality. The Penalty will be levied if the serving cutleries are found to be not meeting the required standards of the Outdoor Catering. A sample of Cutlery to be used during the convocation eve dinner should be brought for the inspection of the tender evaluation committee during technical evaluation on **March 15, 2023, at 11.00 am (Tentative)**. These items will be returned after Technical evaluation. If the serving Cutlery is not as per the sample shown by the vendor, a penalty shall be imposed by IIM Tiruchirappalli.
- e. The Cutlery should contain at least following items:
 - a. Chinaware (Dinner Plate, Quarter Plate, Bowls).
 - b. Stainless Steel fork and spoon.
- f. The servers involved in serving the Dinner should be well-groomed. Excellent quality photographs/videos from previous events organized by vendor, showing properly-dressed servers have to be produced during technical evaluation on March 15, 2023, at 11.00 hrs. (Tentative). Exact date and Time will be communicated later.
- g. The vendor has to provide Display Boards for the food items served during the Dinner. In the display boards, Vegetarian and Non-Vegetarian items should be clearly marked with **green** and **red-coloured** circles as per prevailing norms.
- h. The vendor should ensure that none of the menu items should get exhausted before the given closure time. If any such items get exhausted in the Dinner, it would be viewed seriously by IIM Tiruchirappalli, and such lapses will lead to invoking the penalty clause, as mentioned above.
- i. The bidders are responsible for the disposal of waste materials at a safe site outside the IIM Tiruchirappalli campus.

6. Packed Tiffin (in Convocation Ground tentatively at 7.30 pm on 05th April 2023)

- a. The Menu for the Packed Tiffin is provided in [Annexure III-D](#).
- b. The bidders should have the capability to prepare all the Packed Tiffin items in the Venue (IIM Tiruchirappalli) and serve it hot/fresh to the members.
- c. All these items to be packed individually with excellent quality food-grade material should be packed in a Cardboard Box and sealed along with a paper napkin and water bottle.
- d. The packed tiffin should be delivered to the consumption points on time.

Note:

1. An exclusive online meeting with the chefs would be arranged before the event to have a clear understanding of our requirements.
2. ***Sample food would be requested for selected food items on April 03, 2023.***

Eligibility Conditions for Bidders

1. The tendering Agency must fulfil the conditions mentioned in the succeeding paras in order to be eligible for technical evaluation of the Bid.
2. The Bidder (s) should be registered with FSSAI and Goods and Services Tax council for the purpose of Goods & Service Tax (GST). A copy of the FSSAI, GST registration certificate has to be submitted with the tender document. A copy of the GST Registration Certificate, PAN and Bank account details should be submitted along with the Technical Bid. The names appearing on all these documents and the tender document should be the same or linked.
3. The bidders should have executed a similar job ***in the last five years as on 31st December 2022***. ***Similar Work shall mean*** the arrangement of large-sized Outdoor Catering (ODC). The bidders should be able to provide supporting evidence such as Copy(ies) of work order(s) and testimonials/completion certificates from Clients and details of current works on hand, and other contractual commitments shall be provided by the Bidder as on ***31st December 2022*** as detailed below;



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At least one similar Work of 80% of the estimated cost [Order copy to be enclosed]

OR

At least two similar works of 60% of the estimated cost each [Order copy to be enclosed]

OR

At least three similar works of 40% of the estimated cost each. [Order copy to be enclosed]

4. **Performance Certificates** from past clients of equivalent order sized (issued in the last five years as on 31st December 2022) need to be attached with the Tender document. The Bidders are requested to attach at least five photographs for each of the events (preferably of different food counters / locations of each of the events) on which they are getting qualified.
5. Average Annual Turnover of the Bidder, pertaining to the best three years out of the last five years (2017-18 to 2021-22), should be at least 100% of the estimated cost of the tender. ***In this regard, the documents pertaining to best three years out of the last five years will be taken into consideration.*** Copies of duly audited Balance Sheet with Profit & Loss accounts are to be submitted for the last five years as above as per [Annexure-I](#) (Technical Bid). The year in which no turnover is shown would also be considered for working out the average.
6. Bidders should be regular in filing Income-Tax returns. A copy of the Income-tax returns filed and audited accounts statement for the last five financial years (2017-18 to 2021-22) should be submitted along with the Technical Bid.
7. The bidders should not be blacklisted by any department of the Government of India or any State Government and Private organization in the past. There should not be any criminal case registered against the bidding firm or its owners/partners anywhere in India and the Bidder should give a self-declaration certificate for acceptance of all terms & conditions of tender documents. An undertaking to this effect in the Company letterhead duly signed by the owner/partner or both to be enclosed, as per [Annexure-IV](#).

Instructions to Bidders

1. Downloading of Tender Document

Tender Documents are to be downloaded from the Institute's website <https://www.iimtrichy.ac.in/tender-published>. No Tender fee is payable.

2. Earnest Money Deposit

- a. The Bidder (s) should remit an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of **Rs. 75,000/- (Seventy-Five Thousand Rupees only)** to our Institute account as mentioned on Page 1. A copy of the payment transaction receipt has to be attached along with the Tender application form, without which the tender won't be considered for the bidding process.

- b. The EMD of the successful Bidder will be adjusted against the Interest Free Security Deposit.
- c. The EMD of the unsuccessful bidders will be released after finalization of the tender. No interest is payable on the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD).
- d. Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) firms as defined in MSE Procurement Policy issued by Department of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) or the firms registered with the Central Purchase Organization or the concerned Ministry or Department or Startups as recognized by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP) for all these items only, are exempted from EMD. However, they have to enclose valid self-attested registration certificate(s) along with the tender to this effect, failing which the Tender will not be considered for evaluation.
- e. The bidders who seeks exemption from EMD as per clause above, if they withdraw or modify their bids during the period of validity, or if they are awarded the contract and they fail to sign the contract, or to submit a performance security before the deadline defined in the bid document, they will be suspended for the period of three years or as decided by the competent authority from being eligible to submit bids for contracts with the entity that invited the bids.

3. Relationship Certificate

- a) The Bidder should give a certificate that none of his/her near relative is working in the units as defined below where he is going to apply for the Tender. In case of proprietorship firm certificate will be given by the proprietor. For partnership firm certificate will be given by all the partners and in case of limited Company by all the Directors of the Company. Due to any breach of these conditions by the Company or firm or any other person, the Tender will be cancelled, and Bid Security will be forfeited at any stage whenever it is noticed, and IIM Tiruchirappalli will not pay any damage to the Company or firm or the concerned person.
- b) The Company or firm or the person will also be debarred for further participation in the concerned unit.
- c) The near relatives for this purpose are defined as follows: -
 - Members of a Hindu undivided family,
 - Spouse,
 - The one is related to the other in the manner as father, mother, son(s) & Son's wife (daughter in law), Daughter(s) and daughter's husband (son in law), brother(s) and brother's wife, sister(s) and sister's husband (brother in law).
- d) The Relationship Certificate ([Annexure-IV](#)) needs to be placed in the Technical bidcover.

4. Conditional Bids

Conditional bids or Bids based on the process / basic schemes other than mentioned and / or not conforming to the technical specifications/requirements of the Bidding documents will not be considered.

5. Technical Bids Criteria

- i. The technical Bid shall contain all the relevant information which forms part of the technical Bid. The information provided in the technical Bid will be used for understanding and assessing/evaluating the quality of the solution being proposed by the Bidder.
- ii. All the information should be organized in logically structured form and uploaded in PDF Format as a technical Bid with an index. Bidders should comply with the scope of Work, eligibility criteria and technical requirements. The detailed formats are attached at [Annexure-I](#). The Bidder is to complete the same in all respect and submit accordingly. No deviations are acceptable in [Annexure-I](#).

6. Price Bid Details

- a. The Price Bid should be submitted strictly as per the BoQ attached in [Annexure -II](#) format, failing which the offer will be rejected. (renaming or changing the format of BoQ) will not be acceptable Tender must be submitted with the rates for all the item(s) of the services involved, and any incomplete tender will not be considered.
- b. The rates quoted by the tenderer should be 'all inclusive' of Delivery / Service Charges and Transport charges. Dish wise, labour – cooking/serving, transport charges, service charges, loading, unloading Charges, taxes etc. *except GST* and must hold good till the completion of Work and shall not be subjected to any escalation. No claim on this account whatsoever shall be entertained at any stage, including the extended period, if any.
- c. Vendor should quote rates in the Price Bid ([Annexure -II](#)) only, bids indicating rates anywhere else will be rejected.
- d. Arithmetical errors, if any, shall be rectified on the following basis. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and total price, then the unit price shall prevail, and the Institute shall correct the total price. If the Bidder does not accept the correction of the errors, the Bid shall be rejected.
- e. In case of any additional requirements on need basis, the Bidder should provide the same and the payment will be made as per the mutually agreed rate considering the prevailing market rate.

7. Validity of Bids and Rates

- i. All the quoted rates would be valid until the completion of the Contract. No escalation of price whatsoever would be allowed during the currency of the Contract, including an extended period, if any.
- ii. The quote shall remain valid and open for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of the price bid.

Bid Preparation

- a. Bidder should take into account any corrigendum published on the tender document before submitting their bids.
- b. Please go through the tender advertisement and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the Bid.
- c. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents - including the names and content of each of the documents that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to the rejection of the Bid.

Procedure for Submission of Bids

- a) The tender document should be downloaded from the IIM Tiruchirappalli website <https://www.iimtrichy.ac.in/tender-published>
- b) The Bidder needs to fill, sign and seal the required bid documents as indicated in the tender document.
- c) The Bidder should submit the Bid in two parts viz. **Technical Bid** and **Price Bid**. Technical Bid along with required documents should be attached in Cover-1. **Price Bid as per Annexure-II** only should be submitted in Cover- 2.
- d) All the pages of the tender document being submitted must be duly signed as per the procedures and requirements stipulated herein.
- e) The Bidder (s) shall not make any changes or amendments in the tender document as published in the IIM Tiruchirappalli website.
- f) All correspondence and documents relating to the Tender shall be written in English.
- g) No addition or alteration should be made in the tender document.
- h) The tender document should be filled in legible handwriting/printing/typing without ambiguity.
- i) If any correction is necessary in the information provided by the Bidder, the same should be made after scoring out the old entry. In any case, there should not be any overwriting. All the corrections should be attested with the full signature of the Bidder with date.
- j) It is construed that the Bidder has read all the terms and conditions before submitting their offer. An undertaking as given in **Annexure-IV** to the effect of stating that all the terms and conditions of the Tender have been read and abided by the tenderer shall be furnished.
- k) Bidder should take into account the corrigendum/Addendum published from time to time before submitting the bids.
- l) The bidders are cautioned that furnishing of incomplete/ambiguous information, suppression of facts and any alteration of the prescribed tender format will entail outright rejection of the bid application.
- m) Bidders should note that they should submit their price bids in the prescribed format given by IIM Tiruchirappalli, and no other format is acceptable.

1. Bids Submission:

Since this tender is based on two bid system, The bids (complete in all respect) must be submitted in *Three Separate Sealed Envelopes* as explained below:

a. Technical Bid – (Cover 1)

The following documents are to be furnished by the Bidders along with the Technical Bid ([Annexure-I](#)), as per the tender document;

- i. Application form, Near Relative and Declaration form as per [Annexure - IV](#).
- ii. Copy of FSSAI, PAN and GST Registration.
- iii. Copy of constitution or legal status of the service provider /Sole proprietorship/firm Agency etc., like an Attested copy of the deed of partnership, if the firm is a partnership concern. Certificate of Incorporation duly certified in case of Company.
- iv. Copy of work orders, testimonials / completion / performance certificate from the present and past clients of equivalent order sized (*received in the last five years as on 31st December 2022*) with verifiable contacts need to be attached with the Tender document.
- v. 5 Photographs of each events done by the bidder.
- vi. A copy of Income tax returns filed and audited accounts statement for the last five financial years (2017-18 to 2021-22).
- vii. Signed Tender document and its all annexures and Corrigendum/Addendum if any.
- viii. All other documents mentioned in the tender document, except the Price Bid document.
- ix. The Technical Bid Cover with the aforementioned required enclosures should be in sealed condition and SUPERSCRIBED with the following text: “*Technical Bid for Providing Catering Services along with Infrastructure arrangements for the Eleventh Annual Convocation at IIM Tiruchirappalli*”

b. Price Bid - (Cover 2)

Price bid (As per [Annexure-II](#) duly filled and signed) - Price must be quoted as per the format specified for all the items, failing which tender shall be rejected.

Only duly filled Price Bid as per [Annexure-II](#) should be put in a separate cover and the cover should be in sealed condition. This envelope should be SUPERSCRIBED with the following text: “*Price Bid for Providing Catering Services along with Infrastructure arrangements for the Eleventh Annual Convocation at IIM Tiruchirappalli*”

Opening of Technical Bid

The technical Bid will be opened by the Tender Opening Committee on **14.03.2023 at 10.00 Hrs.**

Tender Evaluation Process

- Selection of the vendor shall be based on **Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS)** under the Rule 192 of the General Financial Rule 2017. The proposals will be evaluated by taking the following factors into consideration.
- The final selection of the vendor shall be based on Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) with **60% weightage for technical** evaluation and **40% weightage for commercial** evaluation.
- The Bidder would be selected based on ranking and evaluation of Technical and Price Bids by the Evaluation Committee formed by the Institute, and the Committee's decision would be final and binding.

The process of selection of the successful Bidder would be determined as under: -

Stage 1:

Document verification – To verify the document submitted by the bidders. The qualified bidders in **Stage-1** shall be invited to make a presentation in person to the Evaluation Committee of IIM Tiruchirappalli. The Bidders meeting all the basic eligibility conditions mentioned at this tender document will only be considered to make the presentation to the Evaluation Committee.

Stage 2:

Technical Evaluation – Those qualified in **Stage-1** shall be invited to make a demo of the Cutlery and show the excellent quality photographs/videos of the properly dressed Servers from previous events organized by vendor and the bidders need to show the sample table and chair clothes/covers to be used during the event, followed by a presentation to the Evaluation Committee in the Deans' Office Meeting of IIM Tiruchirappalli. Bidders / Representatives have to send the scanned copy of letter of authorization from their firm (or firms they are representing) to purchase@iimtrichy.ac.in to participate in the presentation as per the format enclosed vide **Annexure-V**. The Committee will assess the firm as per criteria mentioned in the technical bid.

The information provided in the technical bid will be used for understanding and assessing/evaluating the quality of solution being proposed by the Bidder. Technical evaluation of the Bidder will depend on the information provided herein and the demo cum presentation to the committee members. **Technical bid score, out of 100**, will be arrived based on the following Parameters:

The security deposit will be refunded to the vendor along with payment of the final bill.
- b) Performance Security will be forfeited if the Service Provide fails to perform/abide by any of the terms or conditions of the Contract.

9. Safety of Working Personnel

17. 23. Force Majeure:
