The Centre works on four major thrust areas of research viz., Crop Improvement, Crop Production, Post Harvest Management and Crop Protection. It has well-equipped laboratories for tissue-culture, bio-technology, soil science, nutrient management, physiology, biochemistry, entomology, nematology, fungal, bacterial, viral pathology and post harvest technology research.</p>

Bus	1730	<p>Kallanai Dam: India is a land rich with history, and one of its many wonders is the Kallanai Dam. Also known as the Grand Anicut, the dam is thought to be the oldest dam in the world that's still in use. The dam is now in the Indian state of Tamil Nadu, but its history goes back around 1,750 years before the creation of the state.</p> <p>The Man Behind the Dam Karikala Chola is known as the man responsible for the Kallanai dam. As King of the Chola Dynasty during the Sangam period, Karikala came into power sometime around 190 AD.</p> <p>The dam is truly a sight to see. It is around a third of a kilometer long and twenty meters wide, or 1,079 feet long and 66 feet wide. It stretches across the Kaveri river and is said to spread water from the river over 400,000 hectares of land, or 1,544 square miles!</p>

					Bus	1130	Dhanushkodi Beach: The word Dhanushkodi means 'Tip of the bow'. 'Arichal Munai' is the point at which the Indian Ocean meets the Bay of Bengal and the spot can be viewed from Dhanushkodi. It is believed that Lord Rama, from the Indian epic of Ramayana, pointed to the end of his bow and asked his troops to build a bridge across the ocean to reach the demon king Ravana's Lanka. Ravana had abducted Rama's wife Sita and Rama had to reach Lanka to rescue her. Thus this place occupies a significant and important position in Indian mythology and history.

						1500	Rameswaram Temple Visit: The Holy abode of the Hindu God, Shri Ram (addressed so with all respect and humility) is a virtual paradise for the devout. No Hindu's journey is complete without a pilgrimage to both Varanasi and Rameswaram for the culmination of his quest for salvation and is hallowed by the epic 'Ramayana'. Folklore mentions about God Ram's presence in this land, after his 14-year exile. The Ramanathaswamy temple by itself is a delight for every tourist. With its magnificent, imposing structure, long corridors, and aesthetically carved pillars, the temple is adorned with a towering 38-metre 'Gopuram'. The temple itself was built by rulers in the 12th century with Sethupathy Maravar beginning the construction of the grand Ramanathaswamy temple that boasts of the 'Third Corridor', completed by his successor, Maravar – the longest one in Asia with a 197-metre span from East to West and a 133-metre span from South to North, the third largest in the world! It is said that Swamy Vivekananda offered prayers at this temple in 1897. It is also one of the twelve Jyothirlinga temples, where Shiva is worshipped in the form of a Jyotirlingam.

The temple is part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site known as the "Great Living Chola Temples", with the other two being the Brihadeeswarar Temple, Gangaikonda Cholapuram and Airavatesvara temple.
